II and III. Every change in price reflects what happens in the battle between bulls and bears. Markets rise when bulls feel more strongly than bears. They rally when buyers are confident and sellers demand a premium for participating in the game that is going against them. There is a buyer and a seller behind every transaction. The number of stocks or futures bought and sold is equal by definition.

Stock indexes are the only asset class that have a predictably upward bias over time, making them favorable trading vehicles. E-mini Stock Index Futures trade at a fraction of the cost of regular futures. Micro E-mini Stock Index Futures trade at only one-tenth the cost of the E-minis, making them a good "stepping stone" for less experienced traders. The author has created three models to profitably trade both types of e-minis in trending and non-trending markets, as well as all levels of market corrections. He has successfully traded these models

for more than seven years. With Model 1 and Model 2 it is reasonable to earn an average of \$4,000 a month with the e-minis and \$400 a month with the micro e-minis, trading only one contract on a part-time basis.
