

La Palestina Cristiana I VII Secolo

Esta obra es un instrumento apto a descubrir la memoria que encierra cada uno de los Santos Lugares. El misterio se convierte en realidad viva en la celebración de la Eucaristía. Los sacerdotes podrán preparar la homilía a partir del comentario de los textos litúrgicos (bílicos y eucológicos). Los sacerdotes, religiosos y peregrinos podrán volver a contemplar el Misterio de Cristo en el curso del año litúrgico, en la meditación y oración personal. El Misal oficial de la Custodia de Tierra Santa, objeto del comentario, presenta los santuarios de Galilea, Judea, Monte Nebo, Damasco y Egipto. Cada santuario tiene uno o varios formularios de Misa; cada formulario se explica siguiendo tres pasos. 1. Se da una breve nota histórica relativa a los lugares (título, mención bíblica, testimonio en los documentos antiguos y, más tarde, los libros de la Custodia de Tierra Santa). 2. Indicación de la proveniencia de los formularios (lecturas y oraciones) y citas de las lecturas bíblicas con su título correspondiente. 3. Por último se hace el comentario bíblico y litúrgico de los textos: Objeto de la anámnesis según los textos bíblicos y Aspectos teológicos y pastorales según la eucología. Ambos aspectos se relacionan entre sí. El cuerpo del libro es precedido por un estudio histórico del «Misal votivo» de la Custodia de Tierra Santa, y un segundo estudio teológico de lo que significa y es en realidad la celebración del Misterio de Cristo en los Santos Lugares.

The Life of Peter the Iberian by John Rufus records the ascetic struggle of a fifth-century anti-Chalcedonian bishop of Mayyuma, Palestine. Cornelia Horn presents a historical-critical study of the only substantial anti-Chalcedonian witness to the history of the conflict in Palestine and analyses the formative period of fifth-century anti-Chalcedonian hierarchy, theology, and its ascetic expression. Important themes are pilgrimage as an ascetic ideal and asceticism assurance of theological authority. Archaeological data on many places in the Levant and textual sources in Syriac, Coptic, Greek, Armenian, and Georgian are examined. This book contributes to our understanding of the origins of anti-Chalcedonian theology and the influence of asceticism on its development, the Christian topography of the Levant, and the history of the anti-Chalcedonian movement in Palestine.

This book describes the Church of Jerusalem, as the mother of all Churches, and its liturgy in the beginnings of Christianity. The detailed description of the Jerusalemite liturgy, especially for the feasts of the liturgical year, offers us a vivid picture of Jerusalem's unique role in Christian devotion and the mysterious connection between the Christian faith and the land of biblical history. The presentation of the anaphora of St. James will enlighten our understanding of the Eucharistic prayer in all the liturgical traditions, especially Syriac, Byzantine and Roman.

Analyzes the text of the "Dialogo", an anti-Jewish polemical work composed in 7th-century Egypt by an unknown author (pp. 181-228 contain the Greek text and an Italian translation). It was written in the form of a fictitious dialogue between two Jewish sages and a Christian monk. It focuses on the idea that the messianic prophecies contained in the Bible were realized by the coming of Jesus and accuses the Jews of deicide, using traditional arguments and stereotypes. The work was copied and translated many times during the 11th-18th centuries, in the geographic area ranging from the eastern Mediterranean to Italy in the west, and went through some changes over the years. The version presented here is based mainly on the edition by Arthur McGiffert, "Dialogue between a Christian and a Jew, Entitled 'Antibol' Papikou kai Pili' nos loudia n pros monachon tina" (1899).
