nationalism. Throughout the developing world, there are mass movements of population from rural to urban areas, driven by overpopulation and poverty. Refugees are a growing element in the population movements associated with the new world order that followed the collapse of the Soviet Union.

Superpower confrontations in Africa, Central America, the Middle East, and Asia have led to population displacement across international borders.
