With a good job as an elementary school teacher and a love for her partner, India’s life seems okay at face value. However, with a chronic mental illness that causes her to have panic attacks regularly, each day can be a struggle. This wonderful story of perseverance is beautifully and meticulously illustrated by Ilaria Urbinati, and wonderfully written by Brian Freschi, allowing India to be connectable to all audiences.

THE MISADVENTURES OF FIVE CHARMING TROUBLEMAKERS Anouk Ricard’s Anna and Froga features the adventures of a little girl named Anna and her gang of animal friends. Anna’s best friend is the titular Froga, and they often hang out with Bubù the dog (an aspiring artist), Christopher the gourmand earthworm, and Ron (a practical joker of a cat). With a sly humor, Ricard spins yarns that will delight and entertain the whole family. Whether the conflict is driven by eating too many French fries, bossing around Johnny the Tuna, or trying to beat a difficult video game, you know that Anna, Froga, Bubù, Ron, and Christopher will come out all right in the end, which makes the layers of confusion they pile on one another all the funnier. Ricard’s characters are sweet without ever veering into preciousness, as they constantly find opportunities for a laugh at one another’s expense. Ricard works in a fanciful and childlike style, with vibrant colors and simple story lines. The illustrations in Anna and Froga are inviting and the stories well told, employing short, snappy dialogue. Without sacrificing quality, intelligence, or humor, Angoulême Festival–nominated author Ricard is able to write from childhood effectively and charmingly. Quasi due anni di blog. Un libro importante, difficile da inquadrare in poche parole, che raccoglie le due storie già apparse su Internazionale e quasi duecento pagine in più di diario di quei viaggi nel Rojava, la regione che i curdi stanno cercando di trasformare in un'utopia democratica senza uguali in Medio Oriente e forse al mondo.

Questo libro è stato la prima raccolta di storie del blog di Zerocalcare, ma negli anni è diventato molto di più, e ora è considerato una parte fondamentale del suo catalogo. La lunga storia a colori che punteggia i capitoli della raccolta è stata la prima presa di coscienza lunga sul percorso, umano, politico e artistico, dell'autore nella sua età adulta. The first entry in Alcott's wonderful 'Lulu's Library' trilogy gets the series off to a flying start, packed with wonderful fairy tales, fantastical worlds and amazing heroes and heroines. As is the case with much of Alcott's work, profound moral lessons are weaved in to the fabric of her stories and this collection is no different. 'A Christmas Dream' focuses heavily on teaching children to look out for those less fortunate in society, where others such as 'Skipping Shoes' focus on the importance of telling the truth and doing the right thing. The moral lesson is never in your face however, they are merely a byproduct of wonderfully crafted, beautiful stories. This collection is perfect for some bed time reading, or anyone looking for a more kid friendly version of the 'Brothers Grimm' fairy tales. Louisa May Alcott (1832-1888) was an author, abolitionist and proud feminist.
