This Selected Issues paper and Statistical Appendix examines external competitiveness and the exchange rate for the Slovak Republic. The results suggest that the unfavorable outcomes in the merchandise trade balance and the current account from 1996 to 1998 reflected, at least in part, competitiveness problems. For most of its working life--which began in 1935--the social security system has been the most and creditable social program in the United States. Its benefits have grown over the years--and in nominal terms, but in real ones as well. Public trust in its soundness has been as close to universal as its coverage, which now stands at nearly 94 percent of the working population. By the early 1970s, however, serious cracks in the financial underpinnings of the system began to be widely noted, leading to a crisis of public confidence that developed--with some clamoring to get out of the system
