"Title 36. Sec. 309.2 requires the Insurance Commissioner to conduct a financial audit of all domestic insurance companies including pre-paid funeral trust accounts. The cost of those audits is borne by the company being audited. Senate Bill 289, currently assigned to the Natural Resources Subcommittee of the House Appropriations and Budget Committee, would require the state to pay the cost of these audits. This bill would have a large negative effect on General Revenue. The cost of an audit is a significant burden on some small funeral homes. The Insurance Department is working with funeral homes to make the audits less burdensome. This study will examine the impact on funeral homes, the accommodations the Insurance Department is undertaking and the cost to General Revenue if SB 289 becomes law. Also, it will consider alternative remedies for auditing funeral home trusts."--Study proposal request.
