**According to Article 6(3) of Directive 2007/43/EC (the "Directive"), the Commission shall submit to the European Parliament and to the Council a report concerning the application of the Directive and its influence on the welfare of chickens, as well as the development of welfare indicators. This study, carried out by the Food Chain Evaluation Consortium, and led by Agra CEAS Consulting, provides an overview of broiler production in the EU. It also sets out the implementation of the Directive and the use made of animal-based welfare indicators used in slaughterhouses to provide information on animal welfare on-farm. The study was based on a literature review, which drew on the European Food Safety Authority's (EFSA's) research into animal-based indicators and DG Health and Food Safety audit reports concerning implementation in various Member States. This was supplemented by an online survey of Member State competent authorities and a separate survey of national AVEC members representing the poultry industry. Full case studies were carried out in the seven main poultry producing Member States (France, Germany, Netherlands, Italy, Poland, Spain and the UK). Partial case studies, focusing on the use of animal welfare indicators, were carried out in Denmark and Sweden. Interviews were carried out with EU level stakeholder organisations.**

This report describes the overall outcome of a series of audits in Member States to evaluate the system of official controls aimed at verifying - and where necessary enforcing- the implementation of European Union food hygiene requirements, in particular those aimed at preventing microbiological contamination of food of non-animal origin. This work was carried out as part of the Directorate-General for Health and Food Safety's work programmes, initially in a series of audits between 2013 and 2016, and a subsequent series started in 2018. The initial series was started after serious food-borne disease outbreaks within the Union were caused by food of non-animal origin. The first series focused on official controls in the area of food hygiene at the primary production stage of food of non-animal origin intended to be eaten raw and, in particular, on controls in the area of traceability of seeds intended for sprouting and sprouts, the applicable microbiological criteria, the approval of sprout-producing establishments, and the controls of imported seeds for sprouting. The report highlights that numerous shortcomings were identified during the initial audits. In particular, the systems in place for official controls on primary producers of food of non-animal origin intended to be eaten raw, were not planned to address the risk of microbiological contaminants; generally, there were no controls related to risks of microbiological contaminants in primary production other than controls over the use of irrigation water. Official samples to verify microbiological contamination were rarely taken. In the case of sprout-producing establishments and suppliers of seeds for sprouting, inspections were not sufficiently effective in verifying and enforcing the requirement that seeds used for sprouting are specifically produced for this purpose, or that they are fit for sprouting. Nonetheless, notable improvements were generally observed as the series progressed. Member States started to adapt and improve their official control systems with more focus on emerging microbiological risks of food of non-animal origin, and they responded positively to the recommendations made in the audit reports. The actions taken by competent authorities were verified in the course of the second series, in which the scope of the audits was extended to include frozen fruits and vegetables - an increasingly important food source, but also associated with food-borne outbreaks. The first six of these follow-up audits demonstrated that, on the one hand, significant progress was made regarding the implementation of official controls at primary production but, on the other, that there is significant scope for improvement as regards the controls over frozen soft fruits and vegetables. It is worth noting that in the reduction of microbiological risks associated with food of non-animal origin, certification schemes and (associated) inspections implemented by major retailers, discounters and supermarkets play a very important role. These efforts are consistent with

the General Food Law (Regulation (EC) No 178/2002), which places the primary responsibility for the production of safe food with the food business operators.
