While there are numerous leaflets, documents and articles available on pucker, we have found that the majority of them lay great stress on "inherent pucker" (only material parameters). In this booklet have tried to include process parameters as well as sewing of lightweight fabrics. All said and done, the problem is so intricately interdependent that exhaustive compilation is well nigh impossible.
