When there was a disagreement, the Area Chair and/or the

Program Committee Chairs provided an additional review. Thus, many submissions were reviewed by four experts. The Program Committee members were deeply involved in a highly selective process. As a result, only approximately 11.9% of the 312 submissions were accepted as long papers, 12.8% of them were accepted as regular papers, and 11.5% of them were accepted as short papers.

They could also represent an alternative to the established, costly habitat management tools.
