*power of the north wind blowing over the edge, by the excessive slant of a few stunted firs at the end of the house; and by a range of gaunt thorns all stretching their limbs one way, as if craving alms of the sun. Happily, the architect had foresight to build it strong: the narrow windows are*

*deeply set in the wall, and the corners defended with large jutting stones. Before passing the threshold, I paused to admire a quantity of grotesque carving lavished over the front, and especially about the principal door: above which, among a wilderness of crumbling griffins and shameless*

*little boys detected the date Ō1500Ō and the name ŌHareton Earnshaw.Ō I would have made a few comments, and requested a short history of the place from the surly owner; but his attitude at the door appeared to demand my speedy entrance, or complete departure, and I had no desire to*

*aggravate his impatience previous to inspecting the penetrulum. One stop brought us into the family sitting-room, without any introductory lobby or passage: they call it here Ōthe house pre-eminently. It includes kitchen and parlour, generally: but I believe at Wuthering Heights the kitchen is forced to retreat altogether into another quarter: at least I distinguished a chatter of tongues, and a clatter of culinary utensils, deep within; and I observed no signs of roasting, boiling, or baking, about the huge fireplace: nor any glitter of copper saucepans and tin cullenders on the*

*walls. One end, indeed, reflected splendidly both light and heat from ranks of immense pewter dishes, interspersed with silver jugs and tankards, towering row after row, on a vast oak dresser, to the very roof. The latter had never been under-drawn; its entire anatomy lay bare to an inquiring eye, except where a frame of wood laden with oatkakes and clusters of legs of beef, mutton, and ham, concealed it. Above the chimney were sundry villainous old guns, and a couple of horse-pistols; and, by way of ornament, three gaudily-painted canisters disposed along its ledge. The floor was*

*of smooth, white stone: the chairs, high-backed, primitive structures, painted green: one or two heavy black ones lurking in the shade. In an arch under the dresser reposed a huge, liver-coloured bitch puppy, surrounded by a swarm of squealing puppies; and other dogs haunted other recesses.*
