Aircraft Communications Addressing and Reporting System (ACARS) is a digital datalink system for transmission of short, and relatively simple messages between aircraft using the airband VHF radio link. The message protocol was designed by Aeronautical Radio Incorporated (ARINC) to replace their VHF voice service and deployed in 1973 format. SITA, a multinational information technology company, later augmented their worldwide data network by adding ground radio stations to provide ACARS service. This book examines the various channels and transmission mechanisms, such as greater openness to trade and foreign investment, economic growth, effects on income transfer and labour migration through which the process of globalization affects different dimensions of poverty in the developing world.

The time has come, the authors argue, for the Korean government to stop managing the economy's structural development and to redefine the responsibilities of business and government. Under this proposed compact, the allocation of resources would shift from the government to the private industrial and financial sectors. The transformation of the government bureaucracy from an ad hoc policy role to one of a transparent and predictable regulator is a key to the success of this undertaking.
