This study will critically explore historical questions concerning the Confiteor and describe the correlations between textual form, liturgical-theological conceptions, piety, ways of living together and social expectations. In conclusion, this study will formulate conditions under which a Confiteor could be meaningful in worship today. Barcelone années cinquante, le jeune Adrià grandit dans un vaste appartement ombreux, entre un père qui veut faire de lui un humaniste polyglotte et une mère qui le destine à une carrière de violoniste virtuose.
