\*\*\*This edition collects the entire four part series in one book. Bestselling author Devon Hartford puts a unique spin on the billionaire romance genre. (Per)mutations of Qohelet explores the question, Who is Qohelet? Rather than peering behind or through the text to answer this question in terms of authorship, Koosed analyzes the identity that is created through the words on the page. The text is not a transparent medium connecting reader with author; instead, it is an opaque body - it has weight, substance, skin. Koosed begins with an analysis of the ways in which words construct identities and the reasons why words can affect us so profoundly, relying primarily on the work of Judith Butler and Elaine Scarry. She then explores autobiography and how the genre of autobiography - as reconfigured by Roland Barthes and Jacques Derrida - relates to Qohelet. These two chapters then set the framework for what follows: an analysis of the various bodily organs and sensations contained within the book of Qohelet. The body is embedded in the text through the naming of body parts (eye, hand, heart). And this same body is encoded in form,

structure, and syntax, so that the text becomes a body with organs, systems, and even a life of its own. The book is a body and the book speaks of bodies. It speaks of the body's organs and senses; it concerns itself with the pleasures and pains of the body, the gendered body, the dying body. Finally, the ritual body is highlighted in the final passage of this enigmatic book.

For those interested in discussion at the intersection of self-improvement, spirituality and faith, this book provides a concise analysis of the philosophy behind the phenomena that is The Secret - Law of Attraction. Some, though it seems surprisingly few, have recognised that with The Secret something is not quite right. The popularity of the film and book is remarkable indeed. However scratch beneath the veneer of the polished and aesthetically stylised multimedia presentation and a striking, maybe even shocking discovery is made. There are three key elements which set this apart from its contemporaries, the first being that it gives an exposition or verse-by-verse annotation of each verse in the Bible.
