The diagnostic process is a complex, collaborative activity that involves clinical reasoning and information gathering to determine a patient's health problem. Just as the diagnostic process is a collaborative activity, improving diagnosis will require collaboration and a widespread commitment to change among health care professionals, health care organizations, patients and their families, researchers, and policy makers.
