These features are most evident in the rhythmic character and style, as well as the overall organizational scope of the suite. An awareness and understanding of these elements and their juxtaposition can enable effective performance of the work. Written for an under-utilized instrumentation, Suite for Winds presents as a vivid and dynamic work uniquely informed by modern dance.*
