Roberto discusses the crucial people skills you need to know and also teaches his unique approach to "situational posing" and group posing.*
- *Storyteller Approach Components. Roberto discusses the five approaches he uses to build a "wedding story" for his clients. These five approaches are: photojournalism, interactive photojournalism, stylized aware posing, stylized unaware posing, and story development.*
- *Expert Components. The final section builds and expands on everything*

And on it goes, picture after tantalizing picture, alive with wondrous beauty. When she created National Geographic Simply Beautiful Photographs, Annie Griffiths set two goals: to maximize visual delight, and to create a book unique in the world of publishing—one in which many of the photographs could be purchased as prints.
