hand, the atmosphere in the Borden household was tense, Lizzie resented her stepmother, she was prone to mental instability, and she had purchased poison a few

days before the murders which police suspected was the cause of food poisoning.

There was a financial motive: Lizzie was upset her father had transferred property she was due to inherit to
