If any proof were needed that the study of prehistoric life is more than a matter of "old bones," then this book provides it in ample measure. From study of fossils and of animal anatomy, plus

detailed observations of the appearance and behavior of modern creatures, the artists have been able to "clothe" the skeleton of each animal, and make realistic reconstructions of physical features, posture and coloration.
