Moreover, it transpires that sensitive information has been insufficiently concealed and that powerful forces from countries across the globe are tasked with acquiring the data in question. A desperate struggle comes about; one which leaves human life on all sides firmly subservient to higher priorities. Having lost his best agent and close friend, Toby is confronted by heart-rending choices in safeguarding national interests while protecting as many as he can. This is John Behardien's eighth book and is the third in the Horizon series.
