What does it mean to be a creative individual who is a follower of the creative God? This book seeks to answer that question through collections of essays which offer theoretical and practical insights into making music from a Christian perspective.

Hymnody is widely recognised as a central tenet of Methodism's theological, doctrinal, spiritual, and liturgical identity. Theologically and doctrinally, the content of the hymns has traditionally been a primary vehicle for expressing Methodism's emphasis on salvation for all, social holiness, and personal commitment, while particular hymns and the communal act of participating in hymn singing have been key elements in the spiritual lives of Methodists. An important contribution to the history of Methodism, *British Methodist Hymnody* argues that the significance of hymnody in British Methodism is best understood as a combination of its official status, spiritual expression, popular appeal, and practical application. Seeking to consider what, when, how, and why Methodists sing, *British Methodist Hymnody* examines the history, perception, and practice of hymnody from Methodism's small-scale eighteenth-century origins to its place as a worldwide denomination today.

"Saints and sinners, all jumbled up together." That's the genius of Johnny Cash, and that's what the gospel is ultimately all about. Johnny Cash sang about and for people on the margins. He famously played concerts in prisons, where he sang both murder ballads and gospel tunes in the same set. It's this juxtaposition between light and dark, writes Richard Beck, that makes Cash one of the most authentic theologians in memory. In *Trains, Jesus, and Murder*, Beck explores the theology of Johnny Cash by investigating a dozen of Cash's songs. In reflecting on Cash's lyrics, and the passion with which he sang them, we gain a deeper understanding of the enduring faith of the Man in Black.

The idea for the book came about while I was working abroad on a theater show, with a fair  
bit of downtime. Before leaving, I'd been helping our son, Arlen, as he made first contact  
with a few instruments: keyboards and synthesizers, guitar, and a variety of tuned  
percussion instruments. It did not always go well. His intense love of music was matched by  
an equally intense desire for immediate results. This combination often led to a considerable  
amount of frustration. To help Arlen cope with this frustration, I decided to write a short  
rhyming story that would be similar in many ways to those found in his favorite picture  
books. My initial vision was for the book to encourage practice and sticktoitiveness,  
enshrining the many virtues of delayed gratification. Mercifully, I came to my senses and  
abandoned that idea as utter nonsense. It dawned on me that our boy's innocence and  
earnestness fueled a kind of rock power, that unnamed spark of creative joy that many of us  
in the music industry have chased in practice spaces and recording studios for decades. It's  
the very thing that makes a kid, a kid. Our five-year-old boy is Thoreau's "childlike

mirthfulness" come to life. He dances like there's no one watching; he doesn't know any other way. He sings with abandon, and sometimes, he roars. In the end, I thought that if he learns something from the book, wonderful, but above all else, I wanted this book to help ensure that he never forgets how to roar.

Western culture no longer has a broad Christian understanding. In fact, much of what American media dishes out is pantheistic or anti-religious. Sociological research indicates that a multitude of beliefs have crept into Christian understandings of faith. This situation is not new. As early as the fifteenth century, Erasmus asserted that the greatest concern of his time was that Christians were most often "rank heathens" when it came to their orthodoxy. It is also apparent that attendance at Sunday school, Vacation Bible School, and other gatherings has fallen at a great rate. The author believes providing Christian education in the context of worship is therefore the best opportunity for reaching believers with historical elements of faith. A twenty-four-part lectionary-based catechetical curriculum is provided for worship. With it, congregations can dwell in a sermon series that is surrounded by supportive full-bodied worship.
