Meanwhile, reform initiatives from without confront the same pervasive political ignorance within the polity that has given rise to this duality. The book sounds a powerful warning about the need to resolve this dilemma-and the mortal threat posed to accountability, democracy, and personal freedom if double government persists. This paperback version features an Afterword that addresses the emerging danger posed by populist authoritarianism rejecting the notion that the security bureaucracy can or should be relied upon to block it. All three are characterized in relation to dialectic at the end of Books VII and VIII (531d–534e). Plato has Socrates describe a group of people who have lived chained to the wall of a cave all of their lives, facing a blank wall. The people watch shadows projected on the wall from objects passing in front of a fire behind them, and give

Puppetry explores the principals of creating rod mechanisms. Hobey Ford tells of his early experiences in puppetry and how he later chose this field as a career. He tells the story of meeting and learning from his mentor Clyde Hollifield. Ford goes on to describe the workings of mechanisms and how he creates small rod puppets.
