"To look to God is to look to the realm of consciousness that can deliver us from the pain of living." "Read my prayers or someone else's," Williamson says. "By all means, create your own." *Illuminata* is a way to bring prayer into practical use, creating a sweeter, more abundant life for yourself and the people you care for. "No conventional therapy," she says, "can release us from a deep and abiding psychic pain.
