I began writing this book when I realized that they could check Facebook, but didn't have the faintest idea how to make the text size bigger on Safari and a number of other things that I thought were common sense after using the phone for a day. If you have been using Apple products for several years, then this book will probably have a few tricks that you didn't know-especially if you are upgrading to the new OS (iOS 6). The book, however, is geared towards those getting started. This book is meant to be a quick start reference. It's not a tutorial on how to use your iPad Mini. If you are looking for something that is more hands on and teaches you how to use the iPad Mini, try the one that came with your iPad Mini (Hint: Open Safari, go to Bookmarks and tap the link to the User Guide).
