The field of antibody diversity is presently enjoying an unparalleled expansion of information, and because of this it was very tempting to await further developments in hopes of tying up as many loose ends as possible. This was decided against for several reasons; the major factor was that the project was growing

burdensome for both of us. From a more objective point of view this appears to be a reasonable time to stop our exposition.
