Modernismo (1880s-1920s) is considered one of the most groundbreaking literary movements in Hispanic history, as it transformed literature in Spanish to an extent not seen since the Renaissance. As Alejandro Mejias-Lopez demonstrates, however, modernismo was also groundbreaking in another, more

In Latin America he is read as someone who reorganized the canon, questioned literary hierarchies, and redefined the role of marginal literatures.
