Aunque para cada carné profesional rige una normativa, de modo que pueden ser diferentes los aspectos exigidos para una especialidad que para otra, en general para obtenerlos es preciso superar unos exámenes teóricos y prácticos que acreditan que se tienen los conocimientos necesarios para ejercer la actividad a la que se refiera el carné. Estos exámenes son convocados generalmente dos veces al año por la Administración responsable y para ser admitidos a ellos los aspirantes deben reunir en la mayoría de los casos los siguientes requisitos: ser mayor de edad y estar en posesión o en condiciones de obtener cualquiera de las titulaciones que se especifique para cada especialidad concreta. Pero además de estas

Certificado de Profesionalidad El Certificado de Profesionalidad es un documento público expedido por el Ministerio de Trabajo e Inmigración que acredita con carácter oficial las competencias profesionales que capacitan para el desarrollo de una actividad laboral, es decir, es el instrumento de acreditación oficial de las cualificaciones profesionales del Catálogo Nacional de Cualificaciones Profesionales, tanto si se han adquirido a través de la vía formativa como mediante la experiencia laboral.
