Restif de la Bretonne (1734–1806) was perhaps the key author amongst a glut of imitators inspired by the publication of the Marquis de Sade's "obscene" masterworks *Juliette* and *Justine* in the late 18th century. In 1798 Restif wrote his ultra-erotic epic *The Anti-Justine* (or *The Joys of EroS*), thus inaugurating a long tradition of "Sadean literature" that continues to this day. *The Anti-Justine* is a vivid and extreme novelization of Restif's own life and sexual debauches, which the author tried to defend "morally" by declaring his book to be an "antidote" to the supposed poison of de Sade; yet whilst the book opens with a spurious warning to women against cruelty, it soon develops into a monumental odyssey of sexual depravity which often rivals de Sade in its relentless explicitness. This new edition of *THE ANTI-JUSTINE* has been freshly translated by Meredith Head (translator of de Sade's *Philosophy In The Boudoir*), and contains an introductory essay by de Sade's biographer Dr Iwan Bloch.

Expressing yourself from behind a screen has always been the easy way out; and for Lady O - pen name of Olyvia Cardoso - writing in this way makes her life lighter, less complicated, and easier to bear. Suddenly, Gerard Gordon comes crashing back into Olyvia's life: one of the main contributors to her suffering all those years ago. Spiteful, arrogant, deceitful...or so it seemed. Could it be possible that this cursed angel, with his sparkling sapphire eyes and spellbinding smile, is exactly who he claims to be? A neurosurgeon who is so fascinated by Olyvia that he wants to protect her, even from herself? From the brilliant mind of Charlotte Lays, best-selling Italian author, comes this moving, ingenious novel, laden with emotion... Because, often, looks can be deceiving - and beauty does not always come from the heart. Charlotte Lays Pseudonym of Carlotta Pugi, born in 1980, who lives in Montale: a pretty little town embedded in the rolling Tuscan hills. Selected by the Modern Library as one of the 100 best nonfiction books of all time From the Modern Library's new set of beautifully repackaged hardcover classics by Truman Capote—also available are *Breakfast at Tiffany's* and *Other Voices, Other Rooms* (in one volume), *Portraits and Observations*, and *The Complete Stories* Truman Capote's masterpiece, *In Cold Blood*, created a sensation when it was first published, serially, in *The New Yorker* in 1965. The intensively researched, atmospheric narrative of the lives of the Clutter family of Holcomb, Kansas, and of the two men, Richard Eugene Hickock and Perry Edward

Smith, who brutally killed them on the night of November 15, 1959, is the seminal work of the "new journalism." Perry Smith is one of the great dark characters of American literature, full of contradictory emotions. "I thought he was a very nice gentleman," he says of Herb Clutter. "Soft-spoken. I thought so right up to the moment I cut his throat." Told in chapters that alternate between the Clutter household and the approach of Smith and Hickock in their black Chevrolet, then between the investigation of the case and the killers' flight, Capote's account is so detailed that the reader comes to feel almost like a participant in the events.

From *The Story of O* to *The Sexual Life of Catherine M*, readers have been enthralled with sexually subversive memoirs by women. Here, Toni Bentley recounts her experiences when she meets a lover who introduces her to a radical and unexpected pleasure.

First published in 1946, *Psychoanalytic Therapy* stands as a classic presentation of "brief therapy". The volume, which is based upon nearly six hundred cases, derives from a concerted effort at the Chicago Institute for Psychoanalysis to define the principles that make possible a psychotherapy shorter and more efficient than traditional psychoanalysis and to develop specific techniques of treatment. While taking a psychoanalytic approach, the authors urge the therapist to plan carefully and sensibly to avoid letting every case drift into "interminable" psychoanalysis. They address not only psychiatrists and psychoanalysts, but also psychologists, general physicians, social workers, and "all whose work is closely concerned with human relationships."

Translated here into English for the first time is a monumental work of literary history and criticism comparable in scope and achievement to Eric Auerbach's *Mimesis*. Italian critic Francesco Orlando explores Western literature's obsession with outmoded and nonfunctional objects (ruins, obsolete machinery, broken things, trash, etc.). Combining the insights of psychoanalysis and literary-political history, Orlando traces this obsession

to a turning point in history, at the end of eighteenth-century industrialization, when the functional becomes the dominant value of Western culture. Roaming through every genre and much of the history of Western literature, the author identifies distinct categories into which obsolete images can be classified and provides myriad examples. The function of literature, he concludes, is to remind us of what we have lost and what we are losing as we rush toward the future.
