Perturbatory narration is a heuristic concept, applicable both quantitatively and qualitatively to a specific type of complex narratives for which narratology has not yet found an appropriate classification. This new term refers to complex narrative strategies that produce intentionally disturbing effects such as surprise, confusion, doubt or disappointment effects that interrupt or suspend immersion in the aesthetic reception process.

The initial task, however, is to indicate what narrative conventions are, in fact, questioned, transgressed, or

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given new life by perturbatory narration. The key to our modeling lies in its combination of individual procedures of narrative strategies hitherto regarded as unrelated. Their interplay has not yet attracted scholarly attention. The essays in this volume present a wide range of contemporary films from Canada, the USA, Mexico, Argentina, Spain, France and Germany. The perturbatory narration concept enables to typify and systematize moments of disruption in fictional texts, combining narrative processes of deception, paradox and/or empuzzlement and to analyse these perturbing narrative strategies in very different filmic texts.

This definitive study takes as its subject a group of melodies copied many times, even within single manuscripts. Professor Randel is therefore able to base his conclusions about the relationship of the manuscript sources to one another on twenty-six separate Spanish manuscripts. He shows that there were actually four distinct traditions associated with these manuscripts instead of two as formerly assumed. By comparing the four traditions, he draws new conclusions about the relative antiquity of the written tradition for these psalm tones, the presence or absence of a modal system in the Mozarabic chant, and the development of the two general types of notation. Far from teleological historiography, the pan-European perspective on Early Modern drama offered in this volume provides answers to why, how, where and when the given phenomena of theatre appear in history. Using theories of circulation and other concepts of exchange, transfer and movement, the authors analyze the development and differentiation of European secular and religious drama, within the disciplinary framework of comparative literature and the history of literature and concepts. 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Taking up the invitation extended by tentative attempts over the past three decades to construct a functioning definition of the genre, Jonathan Bradbury traces the development of the vernacular miscellany in sixteenth- and seventeenth-century Spain and Spanish-America. In the first full-length study of this commercially successful and intellectually significant genre, Bradbury underlines the service performed by the miscellanists as disseminators of knowledge and information to a popular readership. His comprehensive analysis of the *miscelánea* corrects long-standing misconceptions, starting from its poorly-understood terminology, and erects divisions between it and other related genres. His work illuminates the relationship between the Golden Age Spanish miscellany and those of the classical world and humanist milieu, and illustrates how the vernacular tradition moved away from these forebears. Bradbury examines in particular the later inclusion of explicitly fictional components, such as poetic compositions and short prose fiction, alongside the vulgarisation of erudite or inaccessible prose material, which was the primary function of the earlier Spanish miscellanies. He tackles the flexibility of the *miscelánea* as a genre by assessing the conceptual, thematic and formal aspects of such works, and exploring the interaction of these features. As a result, a genre model emerges, through which Golden Age works with fragmentary and non-continuous contents can better be interpreted and classified.

Don Morales tells stories. He tells lots of stories. About Chimbote, the Peruvian town where he lives. About fishing, the lifeblood of the town. And about change, which is not always the same as progress. Stories about the first people to inhabit the region and stories about the people who live there now. Stories about the early people's love of the land and more recent people's destruction of it. Stories about how people used to get along with one another and stories about how things got to be so bad that the government began to murder its own citizens. Don Morales is a wise man. But he is also a sad man, mourning the

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loss of the past, of better times, of brotherhood. With his short, evocative storiesÑtold with simplicity and beautyÑhe pulls his readers closer to him, as if he were speaking directly to us. For the good fishermen of Tancay, life was better yesterday than it is today. It was better to live in harmony with the sea. When they lived in harmony with the natural world, there was harmony in the human world, too. With a nostalgic feel, yet reflecting PeruÕs current political instability, this is a delightful book with an important message. When the natural order is disrupted, it is not only fish that die. RESUMEN: El año 1924 constituirá un momento trascendente en la trayectoria de Manuel Bandeira y Gerardo Diego. Distanciándose de los condicionamientos postsimbolistas, Bandeira publicará O ritmo dissoluto, vinculándose con la fase inicial del modernismo brasileño e incorporando a su poética elementos cotidianos, el verso libre y nuevos metros no convencionales. Por su parte, Gerardo Diego sacará a la luz su Manual de espumas, preocupado por la indagación en la imagen múltiple y la construcción de representaciones que establezcan redes de sugerencias sin

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referencia inmediata. Pese a la distancia entre ambos poetas, su sentido de ruptura sin renunciar a la tradición singulariza su trabajo a partir de la utilización de la música como herramienta de experimentación discursiva. Por consiguiente, este trabajo reflexiona sobre la capacidad interartística de ambos libros en función de la importancia que en ellos tiene la música como indagación en un sistema cuyos elementos, incontaminados frente al lenguaje verbal, le permiten alcanzar el ideal de una nueva belleza que el modernismo y las vanguardias se afanarían en hallar hasta agotar todas sus posibilidades. RESUMO: O ano de 1924 será um momento importante na história de Manuel Bandeira e Gerardo Diego. Distanciando-se da influência pós-simbolista, Bandeira publicou O ritmo dissoluto, ligado a fase inicial do modernismo brasileiro e incorporando objetos cotidianos, verso livre e novos elementos métricos não convencionais. Por outro lado, Gerardo Diego vai José Antonio Paniagua García / De baladas, madrigales y nocturnos: Manuel Bandeira y Gerardo Diego, poetas musicales (1924) apresentar Manual de espumas, preocupado com a indagação sobre as múltiplas

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*reprentações de imagem e construção de redes para estabelecer sugestões sem referência imediata. Apesar da distância entre os dois poetas, o sentido de ruptura sem sacrificar a tradição distingue o seu trabalho a partir do uso da música como instrumento de experimentação discursiva. Portanto, este trabalho reflete sobre a capacidade interartística de ambos os livros segundo a importância da música como uma pergunta em um sistema, cujos elementos não contaminados permitem-lhes alcançar o ideal de uma nova beleza que o modernismo o avant-garde tentam encontrar até a exaustão. Palavras-chave: Manuel Bandeira; Gerardo Diego; música; tradição; ruptura. ABSTRACT: The year 1924 is a very significant moment for Manuel Bandeira and Gerardo Diego. On the one hand, Manuel Bandeira will publish *O ritmo dissoluto*, a book of poems in which he put away his writing from the post-symbolist influence and achieve, in the incipient context of Brazilian modernism, a poetic that incorporates daily elements, free verse and a new unconventional metre. On the other hand, Gerardo Diego will publish *Manual de espumas*, very focused on the inquiry into the multiple image and the building of representations that establish a set of*

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suggestions without immediate reference. Despite the distance between the two authors, their sense of rupture linked to the poetic tradition distinguishes their writing due to the use of music as a tool of discursive experimentation. To sum up, this paper reflects on the interartistic capacity of these two poetry books according to the importance that music acquires in them as a way of inquiry in a system whose uncontaminated elements allow them to achieve a new beauty ideal that modernism and the avant-garde tried to find until the end of their experimental processes. Gabriela Mistral and Victoria Ocampo were the two most influential and respected women writers of twentieth-century Latin America. Mistral, a plain, self-

educated Chilean woman of the mountains who was a poet, journalist, and educator, became Latin America's first Nobel Laureate in 1945. Ocampo, a stunning Argentine woman of wealth, wrote hundreds of essays and founded the first-rate literary journal Sur. Though of very different backgrounds, their deep commitment to what they felt was "their" America forged a unique intellectual and emotional bond between them. This collection of the previously unpublished correspondence between Mistral and Ocampo reveals the private side of two very public women. In these letters (as well as in essays that are included in an appendix), we see what Mistral and Ocampo thought about each other and about the intellectual and political atmosphere of their time (including the Spanish Civil War, World War II, and the dictatorships of Latin America) and particularly how they negotiated the complex issues of identity, nationality, and gender within their wide-ranging cultural connections to both the Americas and Europe.
