In this Act, the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) is charged with recommending and enforcing standards for occupational safety and health, describing exposure concentrations that are safe for various periods of employment-including but not limited to concentrations at which no worker will suffer diminished health, functional capacity, or life expectancy as a result of his or her work experience. By means of criteria documents, NIOSH communicates these recommended standards to employers, workers, and the general public. The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and to others in the occupational safety and health community. NIOSH has now evaluated the latest scientific information and has revised some of its previous recommendations. The 1998 recommendations go beyond attempting to conserve hearing by focusing on the prevention of hearing loss (NIHL). This criteria document reevaluates and reaffirms the recommended exposure limit (REL) for occupational noise exposure established by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) in 1972.
