Asphalt overlays are commonly used to rehabilitate deteriorated Portland cement concrete (PCC) pavements. However, mechanically or thermally driven movements at joints and cracks in the underlying pavement usually lead to development of reflective cracks in the overlay. The formation and propagation of reflection cracking is controlled by the mechanical properties of the asphalt and the condition of the overlaid pavement. Current state of practice for asphalt overlay design is policy oriented and lacking an engineered design approach. There is need for establishing state of practice in design of overlays as well as for assessment of PCC pavement condition and recommending improvements to existing pavement prior to overlay construction. The objective of this study is to develop a simple decision tree-based tool for selecting suitable asphalt mixtures and overlay designs to prolong overlay lives by lowering reflective cracking and improving in-situ density. This research will leverage the current National Road Research Alliance (NRRRA) effort of constructing, instrumenting, and monitoring 12 MnROAD test sections, laboratory performance tests on asphalt mixtures from the test sections, and past field performance data. The proposed tool incorporates field performance data, performance modelling, and life-cycle cost analysis to develop best practices for rehabilitation of PCC with asphalt overlays.

Although family care remains the major source of support for people with dementia, residential care has become an indispensable choice in recent years. The biggest concern is the quality of life of the elderly with cognitive impairment or dementia (QOL-ECI) in residential care facilities (RCFs). Previous studies have explored many individual-level factors associated with QOL-ECI; however, less discussion has been conducted on how to improve it from an organizational-level perspective. China serves as a good research setting for this issue. The present study aims to establish an organizational-level framework to investigate QOL-ECI in RCFs. The Person-centered Care (PCC) Approach serves as an organizational strategy, and the High Commitment Work System (HCWS) is used as a human resource management practice. The study exposes the QOL-ECI status of RCFs in Xi'an China; and examines the relationship between PCC/HCWS and QOL-ECI respectively and jointly. A quantitative research method, survey in particular has been designed to achieve the research objectives, and has been conducted in two phases. Phase one of the study aims to validate a Chinese Version of the Person-centered care Assessment Tool (P-CATC), which is designed to measure the extent to which formal caregivers rate their facility as being person-centered. The resulting 24-item P-CAT-C is validated among a sample of full-time employees (n=330) in all 34 RCFs in urban Xi'an, a city in China. Phase two is a survey conducted among the same 34 RCFs. Full-time employees (n=330) evaluated the HCWS level for each RCF; residents with cognitive impairment (n=307) and their respective personal care workers (n=207) were invited to evaluate QOL-ECI. Hierarchical Linear Modeling (HLM) has been adopted to test the hypothesis. In phase one study, Confirmatory Factor Analysis (CFA) shows that a three-factor 15-item solution of the P-CAT-C provided adequate fit indices to the data ($\chi^2 = 145.69$, $df = 81$, $p > 0.05$). The result of Phase two study shows that the total mean patient-rated QOL-ECI score is 36.06 (SD=8.16) and the caregiver-rated score is 34.09 (SD=6.88). Using caregiver-rated QOL-ECI as the dependent variable, the HLM regression analysis shows that PCC and HCWS are statistically significant with QOL-ECI respectively, and that the HCWS has a positive moderate effect on the relationship between PCC and QOL-ECI. Using patient-rated QOL-ECI as the dependent variable, the hypotheses are partially supported. This study is among the first to report the QOL-ECI status of RCFs in China. It initially demonstrates that PCC and HCWS are positively associated with QOL-ECI both respectively and jointly. It also primarily establishes an organizational-level framework to examine QOL-ECI. This will generate

valuable implications and insight into research, practice and policy-making. Finally, this study further develops the PCC theory from an organizational perspective, and contributes to both management and social work literature by first adopting the HCWS for service organizations for the elderly.

The objectives of this research were the collection and evaluation of the data pertaining to the importance of concrete mixing time on air content and distribution, consolidation and workability for pavement construction. American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) standard C 94 was used to determine the significance of the mixing time on the consistency of the mix being delivered and placed on grade. Measurements of unit weight, slump, air content, retained coarse aggregate and compressive strength were used to compare the consistency of the mix in the hauling unit at the point of mixing and at the point placement. An analysis of variance was performed on the data collected from the field tests. Results were used to establish the relationship between selected mixing time and the portland cement concrete properties tested. The results were also used to define the effect of testing location (center and side of truck, and on the grade) on the concrete properties. Compressive strength test concepts were used to analyze the hardened concrete pavement strength. Cores were obtained at various locations on each project on or between vibrator locations to evaluate the variance in each sample, between locations, and mixing times. A low-vacuum scanning electron microscope (SEM) was used to study air void parameters in the concrete cores. Combining the data from these analysis thickness measurements and ride in Iowa will provide a foundation for the formulation of a performance based matrix. Analysis of the air voids in the hardened concrete provides a description of the dispersion of the cementitious materials (specifically flyash) and air void characteristics in the pavement. Air void characteristics measured included size, shape and distribution.

The primary objectives of this study were to quantify the effect of PCC slurry on roadside soil pH and to evaluate the effectiveness of using compost to at least partially neutralize slurry pH. Soil pH as a function of depth was determined along known areas of slurry disposal (I-90 and SR-195). Soil metal concentrations (cadmium, copper, lead and zinc) and soil calcium concentrations were also determined. Slurry pH neutralization tests were performed by blending compost (from two different sources) with PCC grinding slurry at three slurry:compost ratios and monitoring pH as a function of time. Roadside soil pH was shown to be significantly elevated in some areas along SR-195 and slightly elevated in some of the I-90 sampling locations. Compost was shown to reduce slurry pH from about 12 to as low as 8.6 for a slurry:compost ratio of 5:1 (w/w). No significant difference between background soil metal concentrations and those in impacted areas was observed.
