Dopo che i segreti saranno stati rivelati e i desideri saranno stati confessati, Rhys e Matt dovranno imparare ad avere fiducia l'uno nell'altro se vogliono farcela. Questo significa che dovranno innamorarsi di nuovo e, questa volta, sarà davvero per sempre.

*La letteratura è ossessione. È un demone polimorfo che può assumere le bianche fattezze di Moby Dick o l'aspetto mostruoso dei crostacei di Wells, che può abitare tra le nevi di London, sulle aspre montagne della follia di Lovecraft o nel condominio suburbano di Ballard. È nella luna precipitata in un camino di Landolfi, nell'occhio cieco del gatto di Poe, nei topi di Steinbeck. Si insedia tra le ecolalie di Gombrowicz come nello sdegno con cui l'ingegner Gadda oppone titanicamente un principio d'ordine al grottesco, alla vigliaccheria, all'ingiustizia del reale. L'ossessione è destino e forma, nevrosi e scrittura, e scrivere significa «consegnarsi inermi agli artigli dei demoni». I demoni e la pasta sfoglia è il libro in cui Michele Mari affida alla forma-saggio quel rapporto inquieto e vitale con la tradizione che altrove ha esplorato attraverso il racconto, il romanzo, la poesia. Testi che compongono un'indispensabile cartografia letteraria, seguendo punti di fuga inediti e rintracciando parentele inaspettate: il sadismo di Stephen King e quello di Collodi, la misantropia di Céline e la bibliolatria di Kien in *Auto da fé*, il riemergere del lupo in Buck nel *Richiamo della foresta* e la voluttà con cui Gregor Samsa si abbandona alla nuova identità di insetto. E poi gli innumerevoli mostri e le infinite stilizzazioni con cui ogni grande scrittore non fa altro che parlare di se stesso, dei propri desideri e delle proprie ferite. Accettando sfide spesso eluse della critica, Mari finisce per modellare le sembianze di un nuovo canone, che attinge tanto alla letteratura goticofantastica quanto a forme di scrittura come manierismi e pastiche che, grazie alla loro «natura esibitoria», rivelano la propria paradossale autenticità, il proprio osceno realismo. Ma *I demoni e la pasta sfoglia* è soprattutto una dichiarazione di poetica in controluce, in cui lo scrittore di *Fantasmagonia* e *Tu*, sanguinosa infanzia mostra il suo rapporto vampiresco con una tradizione eletta a dimora, in una dialettica serrata tra mostruosità e stile, morte e scrittura, persistenza dell'infanzia e attrazione per l'abisso.*

This collection of H. P. Lovecraft's work contains 71 stories by the master of weird fantasy and strange horror fiction. The stories include well-known gems such as 'The Call of Cthulhu', 'The Dunwich Horror' and 'The Case of Charles Dexter Ward' as well as lesser known works. The stories are in chronological order, thus allowing the reader to explore how Lovecraft's work developed over the course of his writing career.
