Their stories, together with Annie's, weave a haunting tale of this mysterious, seductive, and ultimately dangerous man, a man whose hand stretched over generations of women at a bend in the river where fate and desire collide. The River Wife richly evokes the nineteenth-century South at a time when lives changed with the turn of a card or the flash of a knife. Together, the books make up an anthology of the 1915 broadsheets distributed by *The Times* to members of H.M. Forces serving in the trenches of World War I. The volumes contain a wide variety of rich literature from before the war.
