The story of Seven Continents, 22 Diaries chronicles the round-the-world travels of Bernd Kiekebusch and his wife Lucy Steinitz from 2010 to 2011. Readers won't find any blood-curdling tales of life-threatening emergencies in these pages. Rather, this is armchair travel of a quieter kind, comprised of insights, interactions and activities that many travelers might have in small doses but few are fortunate enough to string them together over a twelve month period as a single experience. In two countries - Belize and Cambodia - they spent three months each as volunteers. In the other countries (18 in all) they were more typical tourists, except that Lucy and Bernd, an American and German by origin, aren't your typical kind of anything.The authors' story actually began 13 years earlier in 1997, when they decided to solve their midlife crisis by moving from Maryland (in the USA) to Namibia (in Africa), with their two children and their dog Meshugenah. It is in Namibia where they started writing diaries to friends and relatives (soon to be published separately as Baobabs and Camelthorns: Thirteen Years in Namibia with coauthor Mary Konopka, 2018 projected). After their children left home and other obligations subsided, they began to get the itch for another adventure. In early 2010 Bernd had just retired from the Polytechnic of Namibia, where he taught math and computer science. Lucy's office - where she did development work around HIV & AIDS - was shrinking in size. They had no clear idea what to do next. So they took a vacation to Zanzibar where Lucy popped the question: Why not sell our house and travel around the world for one year, including Antarctica? Bernd couldn't resist the temptation. Their philosophy had always been, Make the most of every day. Understanding that there is no better time than the present to jump the fence and live your dreams, they did just that.This book consists of periodic e-mail diaries that were originally sent to about 300 of the authors' friends and relatives from June 24, 2010 to June 24, 2011. It spans 116 pages and contains over 400 photographs, and it just may tempt you to jump your own fence and live out your own dreams, whatever these may be.
