Detailed advice is also offered on proper selection of materials and their placement. The guidance provided will ensure that the reader is fully equipped to gather and assess all relevant information prior to commencement of the final treatment. The treatment itself can range from minimally invasive to more complex depending on the requirements of each individual case. Among the clinical concepts discussed in the book are the use of etched porcelain restorations, minimally invasive CAD/CAM veneers, and the ink glue technique.

In this collection of classic and newly-published essays, Andrew Hemingway exposes the voice of competing class interest in British aesthetics and art theory in the Romantic period and provides insights into landscape paintings by Constable, Turner and others.

Mathematical aesthetics is not discussed as a separate discipline in other books than this, even if it is reasonable to suppose that the foundations of physics lie in mathematical aesthetics. This book presents a list of mathematical principles that can be classified as 'aesthetic' and shows that these principles can be cast into a nonlinear set of equations. Then, with this minimal input, the book shows that one can obtain lattice solutions, soliton systems, closed strings, instantons and chaotic systems as well as multi-wave-packet solutions as output. These solutions have the common property of being nonintegrable, i.e. the results of integration depend on the integration path. The topic of nonintegrable systems has not been given much attention in other books. Hence we discuss some techniques for dealing with such systems.
