Third, how to make schools work for all learners: research on areas such as brain science, pedagogical innovations, and school management has identified interventions that promote learning by ensuring that learners are prepared, teachers are both skilled and motivated, and other inputs support the teacher-learner relationship. Fourth, how to make systems work for learning: achieving learning throughout an education system requires more than just scaling up effective interventions. Countries must also overcome technical and political barriers by deploying salient metrics for mobilizing actors and tracking progress, building coalitions for learning, and taking an adaptive approach to reform.

Capítulo 12: Sigüientes versiones. Este capítulo resume las actividades de mejora continua del equipo durante las siguientes versiones, describiendo la evolución del equipo desde un ciclo de vida basado en Scrum a otro de tipo lean, eventualmente llegando al despliegue continuo.

Capítulo 13: Reflexiones finales. Este capítulo resume los recursos de una metodología disciplinada que están disponibles para su uso.

Apéndice: El Departamento IT con agilidad disciplinada. Este breve apéndice repasa el trabajo en curso sobre el marco de trabajo DAD para afrontar todos los aspectos de un departamento IT. Contiene 10 páginas, usted debería descubrir en este libro una lectura rápida e informativa.

Preached at Enfield, Connecticut on July 8, 1741, this is perhaps the greatest sermon ever preached in America—and is certainly among the most well known. According to the diary of Reverend Stephen Williams who attended the sermon, “Before the sermon was done there was a great moaning and crying through the whole House, ‘what shall I do to be saved; oh, I am going to hell, etc.’” The diary goes on to indicate that Edwards had to interrupt his sermon and come down to minister to those who were under such awful conviction. And so, in spite of what the scoffers might think or say, “the amazing and astonishing power of God” was manifested among the people that day—with many falling not into the hands of an angry God, but into the arms of a mighty Savior.
