Concisely-argued chapters explore a wide range of themes - including rival texts, body politics, ethnic identity, adolescence, sexual identity, masculinity, relations between women, family dynamics, ritual behaviour, language, bawdy, and the commodification of romantic love - and examine the play's striking imagery of disease, blood, and wombs.
