Examination agencies, many of which have followed the same procedures over decades, can learn from the successes and failures of other systems. This book addresses current issues related to the development, administration, scoring, and usage of these high-stakes public examinations, identifying key issues and problems related to examinations in many emerging market economies as well as in advanced economies. The book's primary audience consists of public examination officials on national, regional, and state examination boards, but the book should also be of interest to senior education policy makers concerned with certification and learning achievement standards, to academics and researchers interested in educational assessment, to governmental and education agencies responsible for student selection, and to professionals at development organizations. Os resultados de todo o processo avaliativo são utilizados para dar início a esse movimento, ou seja, das notas, ou conceitos obtidos pelos alunos, o professor apresenta para a comunidade os resultados de cada aluno em uma reunião, a comunidade discute os resultados e sugere ideias relacionadas aos alunos e também aos professores. Suas representações alicerçadas em uma avaliação com base no diálogo e na busca de soluções para problemas relacionados aos alunos e aos pro

que sugere que ela pode ser vista como uma estratégia didática – criada e utilizada de acordo com o tipo de projeto pedagógico –, pois, à medida que o professor analisa o desenvolvimento de seus alunos ou de grupos de alunos, procura subsidiar o planejamento de suas intervenções. Com base na análise das manifestações produzidas pelos professores indígenas, foi possível identificar o núcleo central das representações das razões para avaliar, qual seja, o de acompanhar o desenvolvimento do aluno, com vistas a melhorar sua aprendizagem e, com isso, viabilizar o projeto de educação escolar indígena, o qual está comprometido com o projeto de vida da comunidade.
