The trailers for *Star Wars: The Force Awakens* made a strong impression on fans. Many were excited by what they saw as a return to the spirit of George Lucas's 1977 creation. Others—including several white supremacy groups—were upset and offended by key differences, most notably the shift away from a blond, blue-eyed, male protagonist. When the film was finally released, reactions similarly seemed to hinge on whether or not *The Force Awakens* renewed the “mythic” aspects of the original trilogy in ways that fans approved of. *The Myth Awakens* examines the religious implications of this phenomenon, considering the ways in which myth can function to reinforce “traditional” social and political values.
