The first issue of The Beano was published on July 30th 1938. This is the first-ever history of the best-known British comic of all time, reflecting on 70 memorable years. The book tracks the evolution of The Beano, decade by decade, from the period leading up to its launch The Beano at war, the fabulous fifties right through to the present day: an extensive in-depth look at the development, rise and enduring success of the most influential British comic of all time. Dennis the Menace arrived in March 1951, closely followed by Ken Reids Roger the Dodger in 1953. This is a history which
