'There is one temple in the Universe and it is the body of Man.' – Novalis How are the internal and external forms of the human organism shaped? How does human consciousness emerge? These are questions to which conventional science has no answers. In *The Seat of the Soul*, Yvan Rioux invites us to consider new concepts that can explain these phenomena. Rioux also gives a description of Rudolf Steiner's seven 'planetary seals' from a biological perspective. According to Steiner, these seals are: '...occult scripts, meaning that, as hidden signatures, they show their ongoing etheric impacts on the seven stages of our metabolism'. Between Steiner's indications concerning human physiology and the ancient Chinese view on the subject, there is a convergence of ideas – as synthesized here – that breaks through the boundaries of modern reductionist science, offering exciting perspectives for understanding the human being. Churchland's wry wit and skillful teaching style are evident throughout. He introduces

the remarkable representational power of a single human brain, for instance, via a captivating brain/World-Trade-Tower TV screen analogy. "Who can be watching this pixilated show?" Churchland queries; the answer is a provocative "no one." And he has included a folded stereoscopic viewer, attached to the inside back cover of the book, that readers can use to participate directly in several revealing experiments concerning stereo vision.
