This assures that appropriate airflow is delivered to all rooms and spaces; and that system airflow is compatible with the operating range of primary equipment. The capabilities and sensitivities of this procedure are compatible with single-zone systems, and multi-zone (air zoned) systems. The primary equipment can have a multi-speed blower (PSC motor), or a variable-speed blower (ECM or constant torque motor, or
