Esta norma, a pesar de que se encuentra en sus primeras fases, trata de cuantificar los riesgos de tener un fallo de seguridad funcional y obliga a realizar los cambios necesarios en el diseño para mantenerlo dentro de los límites aceptables de riesgo. Los costes financieros de aplicar una buena ingeniería de EMC están perfectamente cuantificados y siempre serán menores que los que pueden derivarse de situaciones de riesgos en seguridad funcional.
